This is the first attempt at a description of the grammar and lexicon of Buddhist Hybrid Sanskrit. Most North Indian Buddhist texts are composed in it. Sanskrit prosody or Chandas refers to one of the six Vedangas, or limbs of Vedic studies. It is the study of poetic metres and verse in Sanskrit. This field of study was central to the composition of the Vedas, the scriptural canons of Hinduism, so central that some later Hindu and Buddhist texts refer to the Vedas as Chandas. Sanskrit (/ ˈs æ n s k r ɪ t /; Sanskrit: संस्कृतम्, translit. saṅskṛtam, pronounced [sʌ̃skr̩t̪m]) is a language of ancient India with a history going back about 3,500 years.
