Empress Dowager Cixi (Chinese: 慈禧; pinyin: Cǐxǐ Tàihòu; [tsʰɿ.ʃɿ tʰâi.xôu]; Manchu: Tsysi taiheo; 29 November 1835 – 15 November 1908), of the Manchu Yehe Nara clan, was a Chinese empress dowager and regent who effectively controlled the Chinese government in the late Qing dynasty for 47 years from 1861 until her death ...The Qing dynasty came to an end in 1912 and was replaced by the Republic of China. Within a few months after the fall of the Qing dynasty, on 22 February 1913, Empress Dowager Longyu died in Beijing after an illness.Cixi: Cixi, the empress dowager who effectively ruled China for decades and was one of the most powerful women in the history of China.Meares had left Canton [Guangzhou] with two British-built ships, the Felice and the Iphigenia.
