

Download Dubrovnik And Its Surroundings

Dubrovnik (Croatian: [dʲbroʋniːk] ; historically Latin: Ragusa) is a Croatian city on the Adriatic Sea. It is one of the most prominent tourist destinations in the Mediterranean Sea, a seaport and the centre of Dubrovnik-Neretva County. In the most romantic week of the year, from February 14th to 17th, Valentine's Gastro Days are organized by the Dubrovnik Tourist Board in cooperation with the Dubrovnik restaurants. The special charm of this old city are the buildings that have remained from the time of the old Dubrovnik Republic. This city was also built according to the regulation plans prescribed by the Republic, and the result was the present-day look of the old part of Cavtat. On the western side of Dubrovnik, in its immediate surroundings there is the finest Dubrovnik archipelago called Elaphite (in Greek meaning the Deer Islands), closely bound to Dubrovnik and its entire past.
