Behavioral modernity is a suite of behavioral and cognitive traits that distinguishes current *Homo sapiens* from other anatomically modern humans, hominins, and primates. Proponents of the multiregional hypothesis see regional continuity of certain morphological traits spanning the Pleistocene in different regions across the globe as evidence against a single replacement model from Africa. The Multiregional Continuity Model contends that after *Homo erectus* left Africa and dispersed into other portions of the Old World, regional populations slowly evolved into modern humans.
