Kurdish is a language of the Northwestern Iranian group which has likely separated from the other dialects of Central Iran during the early centuries AD (the Middle Iranian period). Kurdistan (/ ʔ k ʔr d ʔ ʔ s t æ n, ʔ s t ʔ ʔ n /; Kurdish: ʔʔʔʔʔʔʔ ʔ [ʔkʔʔdʔʔstʔʔn] ; lit. "region of Kurds") or Greater Kurdistan is a roughly defined geo-cultural historical region wherein the Kurdish people form a prominent majority population and Kurdish culture, languages, and national identity have historically ...History. The prehistory of the Kurds is poorly known, but their ancestors seem to have inhabited the same upland region for millennia. The records of the early empires of Mesopotamia contain frequent references to mountain tribes with names resembling "Kurd." Abdullah Öcalan: Abdullah Öcalan, leader of the Kurdistan Workers' Party (PKK), a left-wing Kurdish militant organization, who became widely known as the strongest advocate for Kurdish sovereignty. As the PKK's leader, Öcalan was also labeled a hero by some Kurds, a terrorist by most international intelligence
