Review. Not only does this volume contain fascinating original essays well worth reading in their own right, it also makes a case, as a whole, for thinking about moral psychology as a central theme within ethics. Moral psychology studies the features of cognition, judgement, perception and emotion that make human beings capable of moral action. Perspectives from feminist and race theory immensely enrich moral psychology. Note: Citations are based on reference standards. However, formatting rules can vary widely between applications and fields of interest or study. Peggy DesAutels's and Margaret Walker's *Moral Psychology* is one of the latest additions to Rowman and Littlefield's Feminist Construction Series and the second volume to come out of the Association for Feminist Ethics and Social Theory (FEAST).
