

Download Nhmrc Project Grant Guidelines

For a Project Grant application to have NI status, each CI (CIA-CIJ) will need to be assessed and be confirmed as a NI by NHMRC. The process to request NI status is outlined in section 5.2.1 of the Project Grant scheme-specific funding rules. Minimum data is a compulsory requirement. Applicants ineligible to apply for NHMRC Project Grant funding are still entitled to apply via the NHMRC process for Beat Cancer Project funding. Applicants need to adhere to Beat Cancer Project eligibility criteria as well as that of the NHMRC if they
